

Locating the Part Number, Serial Number, and Secondary Labels on Alternators

Part Number and Serial Number Label (Red/Bottom)

The part number and serial number on our alternators are located on the same rectangular silver label. To locate this label:

- Identify the alternator housing, which is the main body of the alternator.
- The rectangular silver label is usually affixed to the side of the housing, facing outward for easy visibility.
- The label features the American Power Systems logo on the left side.
- The part number is located at the top right of the label.
- The serial number is situated below the part number and above the website information.
- Clean the area gently if the label is obscured by dust or grease.



Secondary Label (Yellow/Top)

In addition to the main label, there is a secondary label that provides important technical details. To locate this secondary label:

- The secondary label is typically found adjacent to the main label on the alternator housing.
- This label indicates the voltage, amperage, and the sales order associated with the alternator.
- It is important to note these details for any technical inquiries or service requirements.
- Similar to the main label, ensure the secondary label is clean and visible.
